Dear Valued Customer:

Below defines the MAGNAFLUX policy regarding **Product Shelf Life**.

Shelf Life:

- The MAGNAFLUX Shelf Life is the period of storage time during which a material is determined to be fully functional.
- Except as set forth below, **all** (bulk, aerosols, and penetrant pens) **unopened** MAGNAFLUX Materials have a shelf life of **five years**, starting from the date of manufacture.

Exceptions which have a Shelf Life of Two Years

- Daraclean products

NOTE:

- "Shelf life" merely is a guideline for the time for which MAGNAFLUX has determined product quality during storage.
- Aerosols, due to slight propellant loss, may not spray as well after two years
- Aerosols, bulk and Daraclean materials may be fully functional beyond that specified shelf life, depending on storage conditions.
- Type 1 (fluorescent) materials may be recertified at a nominal charge through our PeneCert™ Program.

Date of Manufacture is established from the batch number. Batch numbers are located on the product label for MAGNAFLUX *Bulk Materials* and marked on the bottom of each MAGNAFLUX *Aerosol Can*.


Our batch numbering system should be interpreted as follows:

The first two numbers represent the year the product was manufactured, i.e., "00" = 2000, "99" = 1999, etc.

The third character, a letter, represents the month the product was manufactured. (Excluding the letter I).

A = January, **B** = February, **C** = March, **D** = April, **E** = May, **F** = June,
G = July, **H** = August, **J** = September, **K** = October, **L** = November,
M = December
